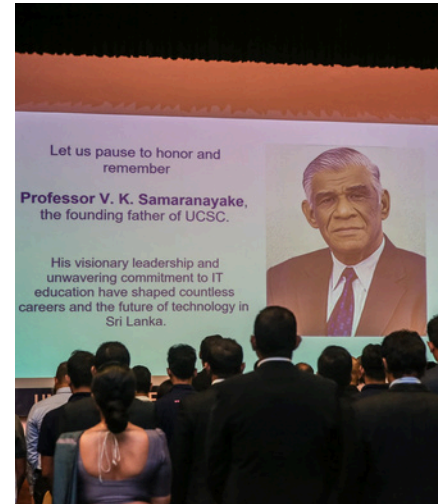

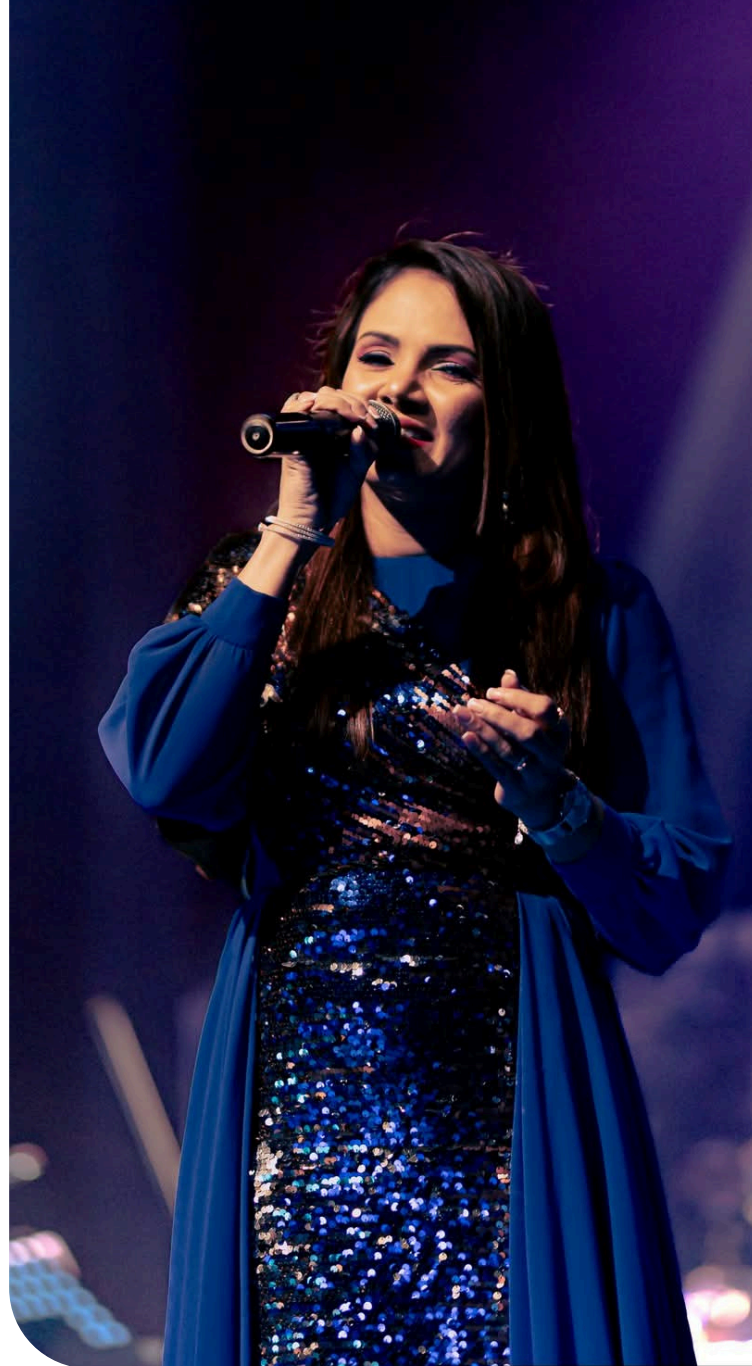


Purpose with Impact

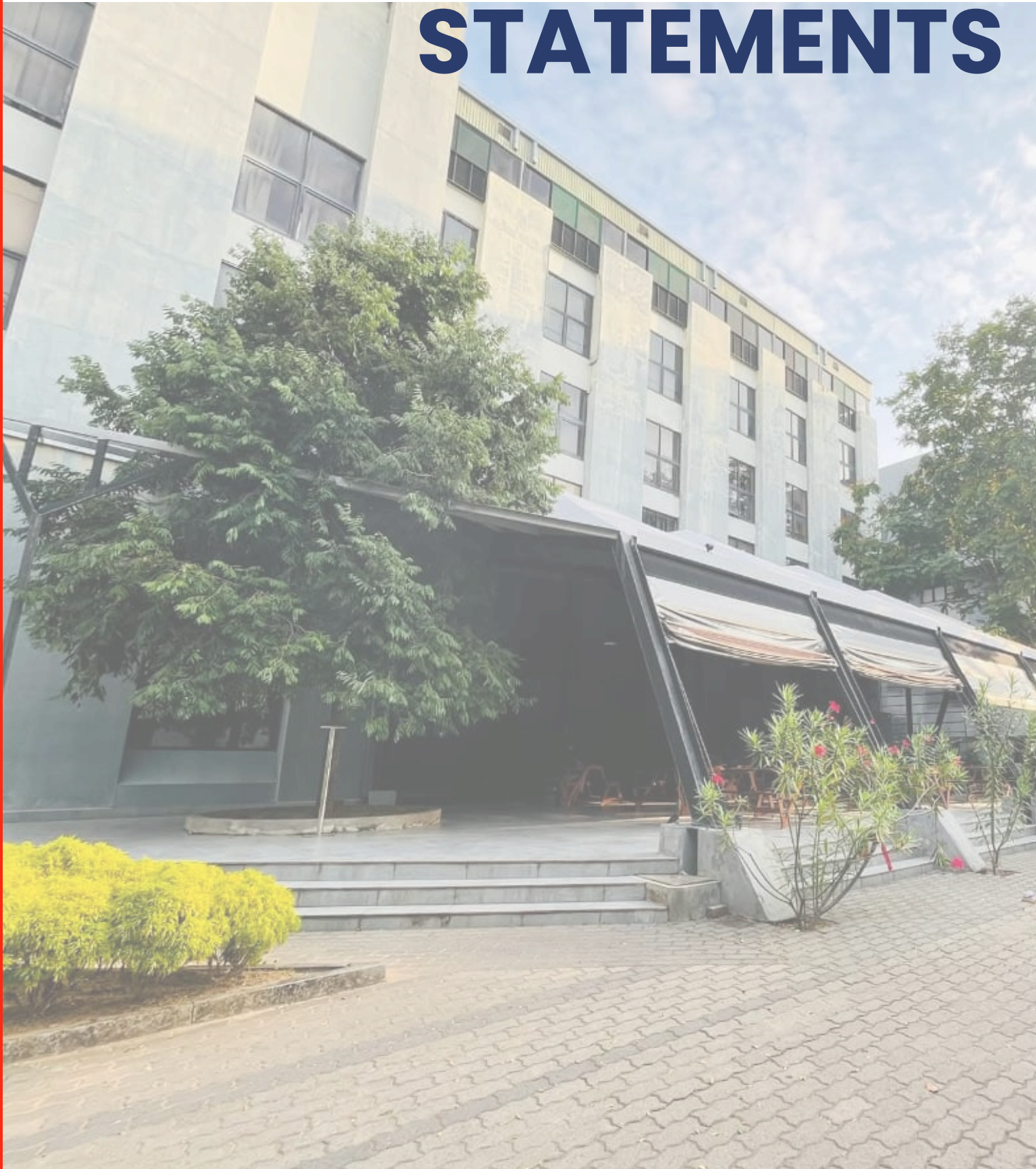
